With a dynamic and forward-thinking approach, FELUBA operates a **National Training Centre** that supports over 50 athletes, including several high-potential players. The federation is firmly committed to a process of **professionalization** and the **pursuit of high-performance standards**.

As part of its long-term strategic plan, FELUBA is recruiting a **National Senior Coach**—a key role in driving the advancement of elite badminton in Luxembourg. A primary short-term objective is the **optimal preparation for the Olympic Games**, which represents a major milestone in the national high-performance agenda.

This position is central to fostering a strong **culture of sporting excellence**, supporting the progression of emerging talent, and strengthening Luxembourg's **visibility and competitiveness on the international badminton stage**.

# **Main responsibilities:**

- Lead, plan, and oversee all activities related to the National Senior Team.
- Develop and implement comprehensive training plans on a weekly, monthly, and annual basis.
- Provide individualized athlete support, including performance evaluations, goal setting, and progress monitoring.
- Organize and manage participation in national and international competitions.
- Promote and uphold a high-performance culture across the federation.
- Collaborate closely with technical staff to ensure continuity and alignment across all levels, from U13 to senior athletes.
- Contribute actively to the education and development of FELUBA-affiliated coaches.
- Support the structural and strategic evolution of the high-performance center.
- Serve as Head of National Performance, working in partnership with federal institutions and external stakeholders.
- Collaborate with sport science and medical staff to ensure holistic athlete development and injury prevention.
- Support talent identification programs and maintain a clear athlete pathway from youth to elite levels.

#### **Required Profile:**











- Level 3 coaching certification or equivalent (e.g. BWF, Badminton Europe, LuxQF Level 5, or comparable).
- Proven track record in coaching at the international level.
- Strong capabilities in project management, strategic planning, and team leadership.
- Demonstrated ability to foster a cohesive team environment, encouraging collaboration, mutual respect, and a shared commitment to performance goals.
- Experience working with integrated performance teams, including S&C, physiotherapy, and psychology.
- Familiarity with performance analysis software and athlete management systems.
- Excellent interpersonal skills, with a balance of autonomy and effective teamwork.
- Fluency in English is required, as it is the primary working language.
- Knowledge of at least one of Luxembourg's official languages (French, German, Luxembourgish) is considered an asset.
- Ability to adapt to a multicultural environment and communicate effectively with diverse stakeholders.
- Proven ability to build and maintain a unified, motivated team environment, fostering trust, collaboration, and a shared commitment to excellence among athletes, coaches, and support staff.
- Possession of a valid category B driving license and access to a personal vehicle are required.
- Proficiency with digital tools, including Excel, Word, and video analysis software.
