2.7. Provisional schedule

Due to organisational changes related to access to the competition venue, we need to update the tournament schedule. The tournament is now planned to start at **09:00 instead of 14:00**. However, depending on the number of entries, the start time may be delayed.

Entry limits: MS 64, WS 64, MD 32, WD 32, XD 48

Note: In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

3.2. Eligible Players

All badminton players born in 2010 or later and who are eligible to play for BWF Members.

3.3. Draw

The draw will be performed by Badminton Europe.

3.4. Scoring System

Matches will be played with BWF 2026 regulations, best of 3x21 points.

3.5. Entries

All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System:

Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID number. In case you wish to enter players, who do not have a BWF ID number, please contact the BWF office well in advance of the tournament, so that the players concerned can receive a BWF ID number before the closing date of the tournament.

No late entries will be accepted.

GCR 7.9: "In making or authorizing entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."

3.6. Entry Fees

Singles (per player):	40,00 €
Doubles & Mixed (per player and per event):	30,00 €

3.7. Payment

Two weeks before the tournament, an invoice will be sent concerning all tournament fees.

All fees must also be paid before Thursday 9th October 2026, for any players listed in main draw and not withdrawn before the deadline. Thanks in advance for understanding.

We prefer to have the invoice paid by bank transfer. At the tournament, payments by card or cash are both possible.

Note:

- 12.1: The Member that enters a player/pair into a BEC U17 Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but the organizers can accept cash payments at tournaments.
- 12.2: The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organizers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.
- 12.5: Organizers are allowed to refuse entries if Members or their players have outstanding fees from a previous year.

3.8. Award Ceremony

There will be an award ceremony for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for each category on Sunday afternoon (no prize money).

6.2. How to book

7. Transport

7.1. Public Transport in Luxembourg

Luxembourg is a global pioneer in public transportation, being the first country to make all public transport completely free for residents and visitors alike. Since March 1, 2020, buses, trains, and trams across the country have operated without any fare requirements.

Journeys can be planned through www.mobiliteit.lu or using the mobiliteit app, which you can download in the apple store or in google play.

7.2. Official points of arrival/departure

- **By train:** Main train station Luxembourg Gare
- **By car:** Venue Coque (limited parking spaces for a fee)

7.3. LUXTRAM (free of charge)



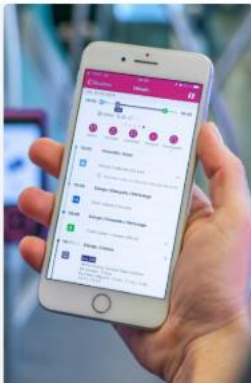
With the completion of the tram line to the airport, the journey from there to the event hall will take only 14 minutes. From the main station, it will take 18 minutes, without any changes or traffic jams.

From the hotels Novotel and Mama Shelter on Kirchberg to the venue

During the tournament there will be no shuttle service organized. Players and coaches can take the tram. You will walk less than 300 meters to take it at “Europa Parlament - Parlement Européen” and then only one stop “Coque” to be at the venue

There is a tramway every 4 minutes.

You can also go on foot. It is 750 meters, around 10 minutes.

8. Advertising & Clothing

Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by the BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations § 12 to 16. For all BEC U17 Circuit tournaments the name on the back of the shirt is optional.

9. Doping information

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

10. Badminton integrity

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).
